Why ClickUP?

 Your experience could be like a thistle or a thorn in your foot due to hick-ups with ClickUP's but it is part of a bigger initiative



- Prof Wendy Kilfoil, Director of the Department for Education Innovation at the University of Pretoria said,
- more than 8 000 students have downloaded the ClickUP mobile application and between 2 500 and 3 200 students access their modules on their mobile devices daily.

With the ClickUP mobile application, students can access course content and also view important class announcements, while some phones allow students to receive notifications about new information or activities within their modules.

Students are also able to read and download assignments or upload content and interact with peers and lecturers by participating in discussions, blogs and journals


