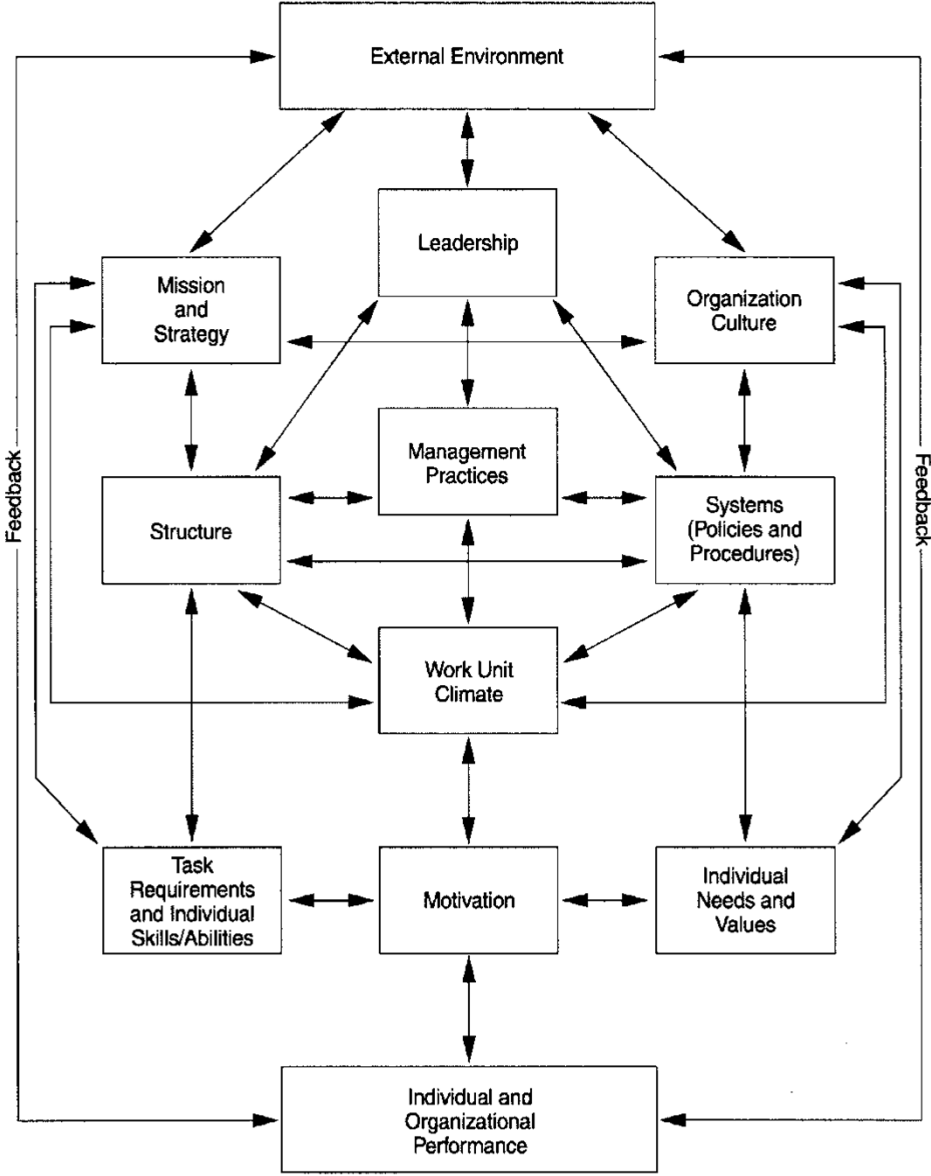

# Embedded librarianship - Research

- In the beginning of last year (2011) the Economic and Management Sciences Library embarked on a turnaround strategy in consultation with the Deans of the Faculty of Economic and Management Sciences. Maureen du Pisanie was appointed to this end.
- Close alignment to new **Strategic Plan** of the Faculty
- Changes to be accommodated - Research focused - Researcher support
- **Burke-Litwin Model** of Individual and Organizational Performance was used as a **structural ability plan**

- Relationships and understanding of the needs of clients are necessary to customise contributions



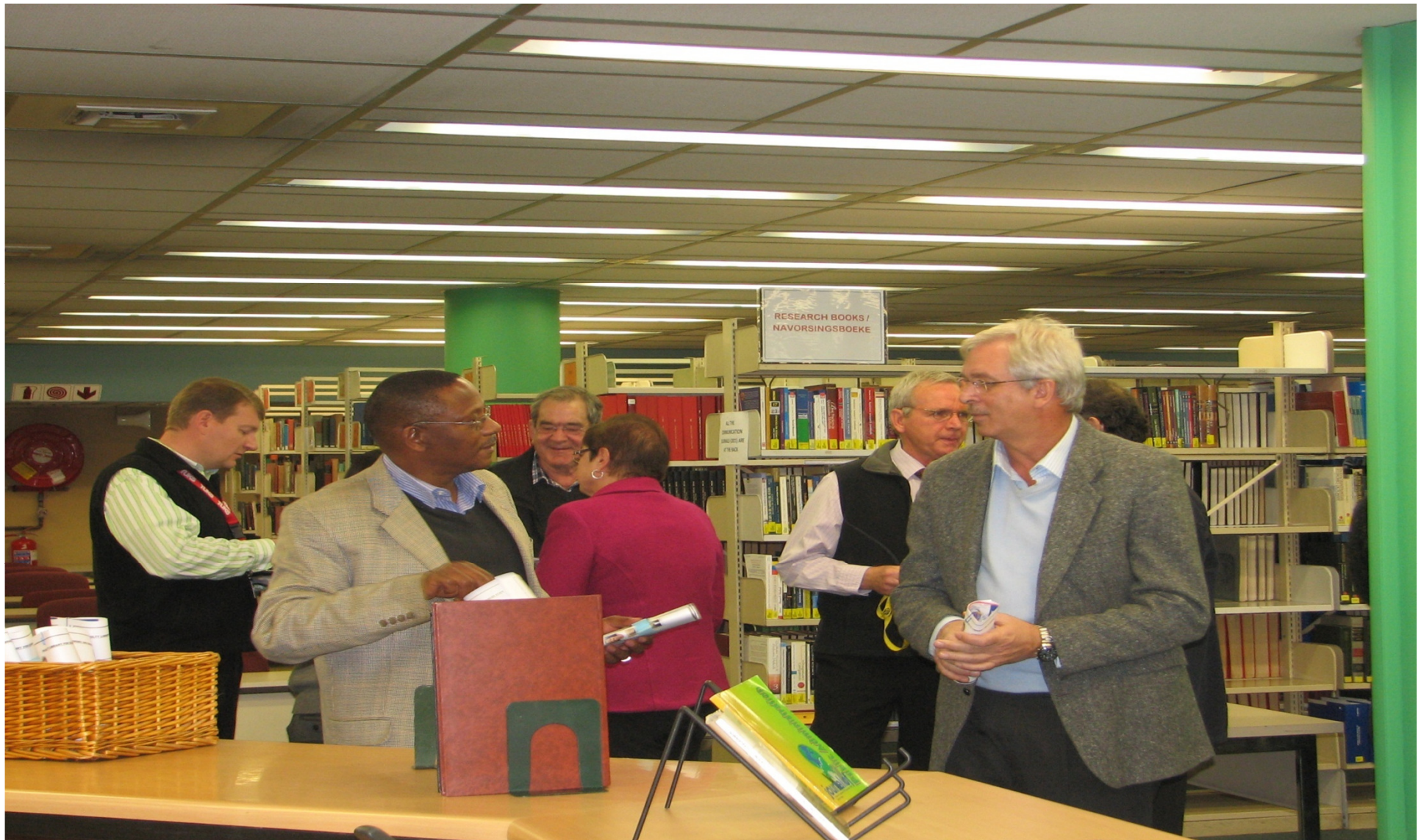

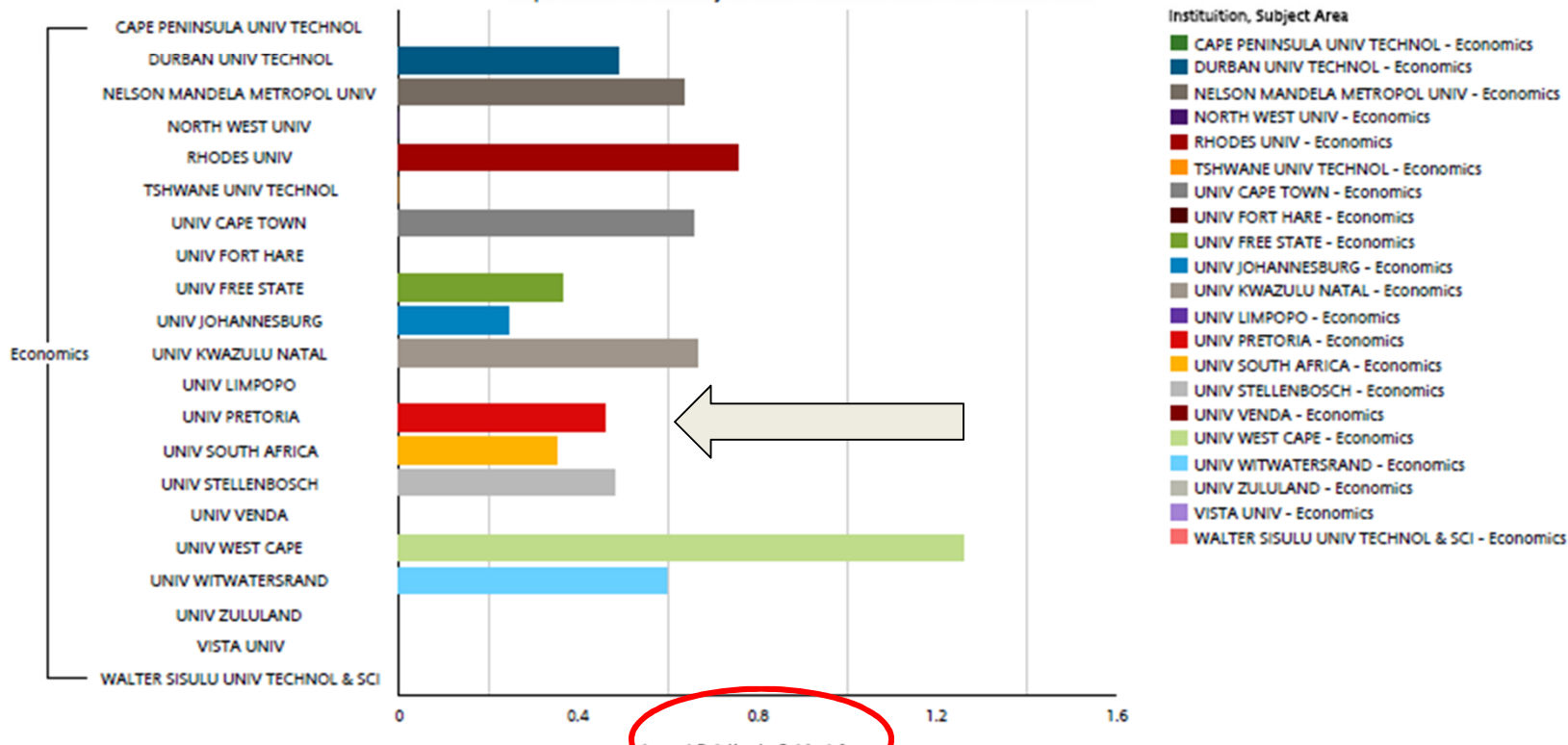

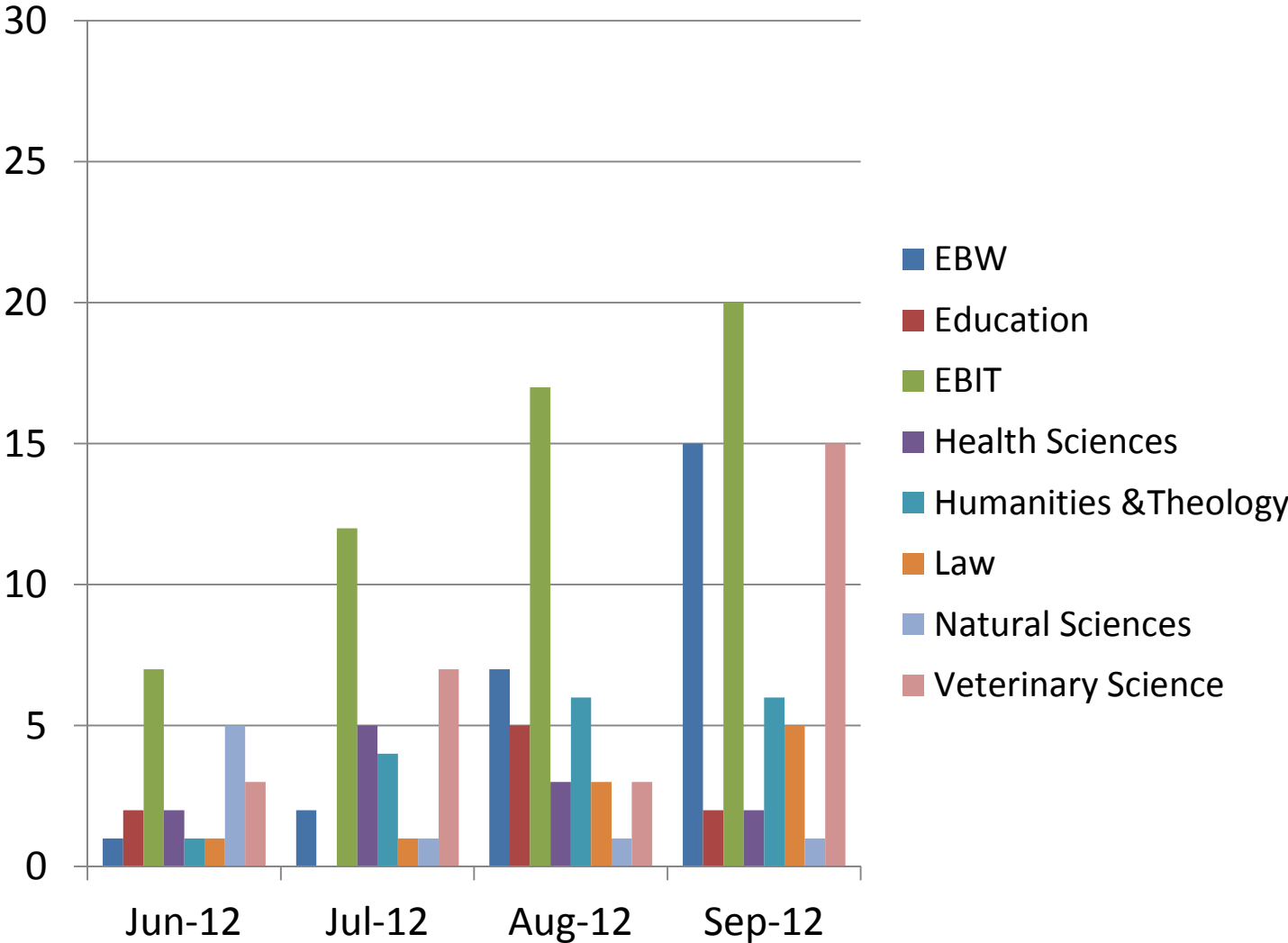
