

## BRIEF CURRICULUM VITAE

Mr Michael Arnoldus Müller matriculated in 1977 from Transvalia Secondary School in Vanderbijlpark, South Africa. He completed his B.A (Honours) degree in Psychology in 1984 and his Masters degree in Theology at the University of Stellenbosch in 1989. In 1990 he completed the Master's degree in Clinical Psychology at the University of Pretoria (U.P.) and did his internship at the Weskoppies Hospital, Pretoria. His mini-dissertation for the MA, entitled: "A descriptive study of the effect of a suicide attempt on the nuclear family", was done under supervision of Dr André Fieldeldey. As a clinical psychologist he worked extensively with clients suffering from depression and other mood disorders. Arnold Müller continued his studies enrolling for doctoral studies in Psychotherapy at U.P. in 1997 under supervision of Prof Rex van Vuuren. After the latter's resignation from the Department of Psychology, Arnold continued with Dr Gertina van Schalkwyk completing his doctoral thesis entitled: "An exploration of significant themes in the diary of a person who committed murder". In 2002 he moved to Ontario, Canada, where he is currently practicing as psychometrist / psychotherapist in educational and rehabilitation psychology.
