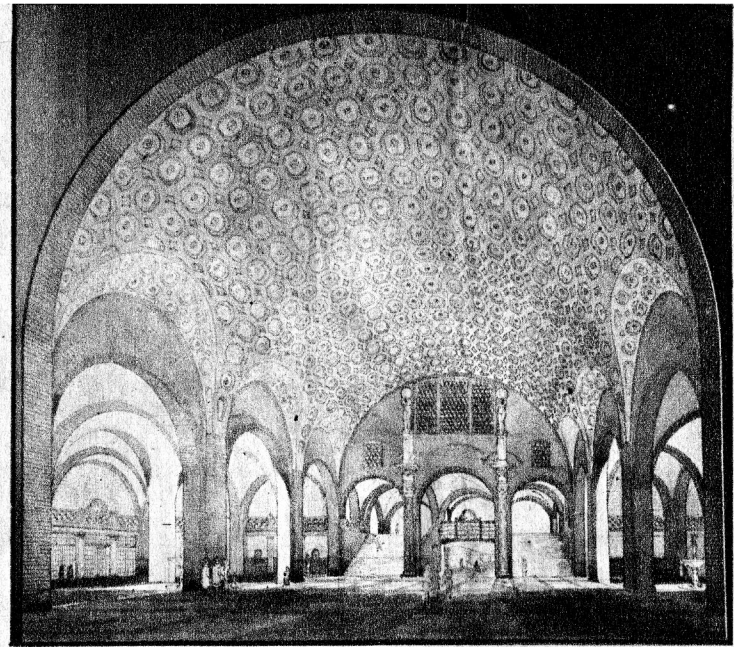
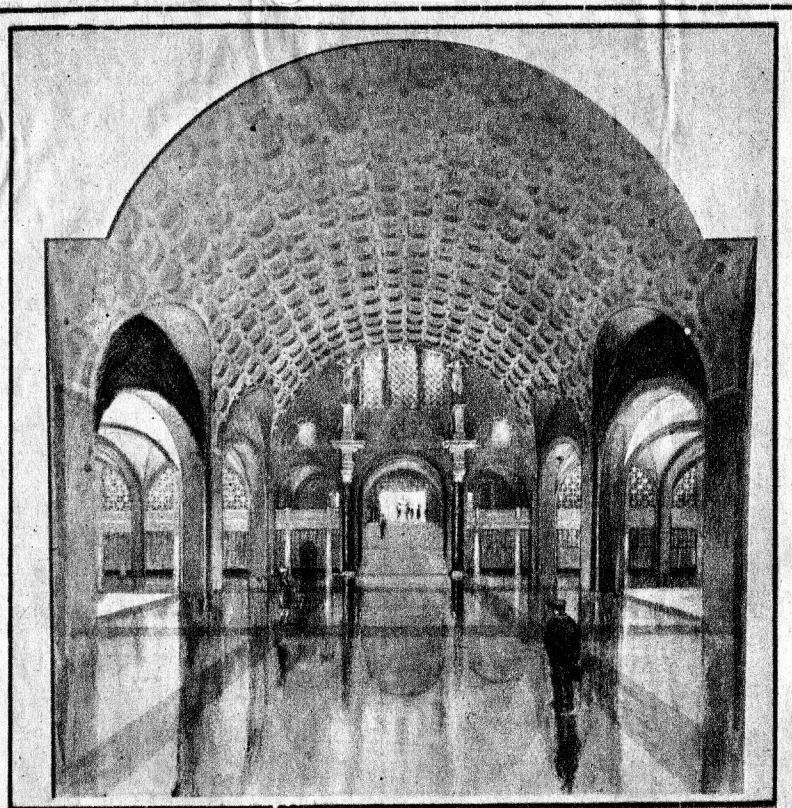

the Roman style.

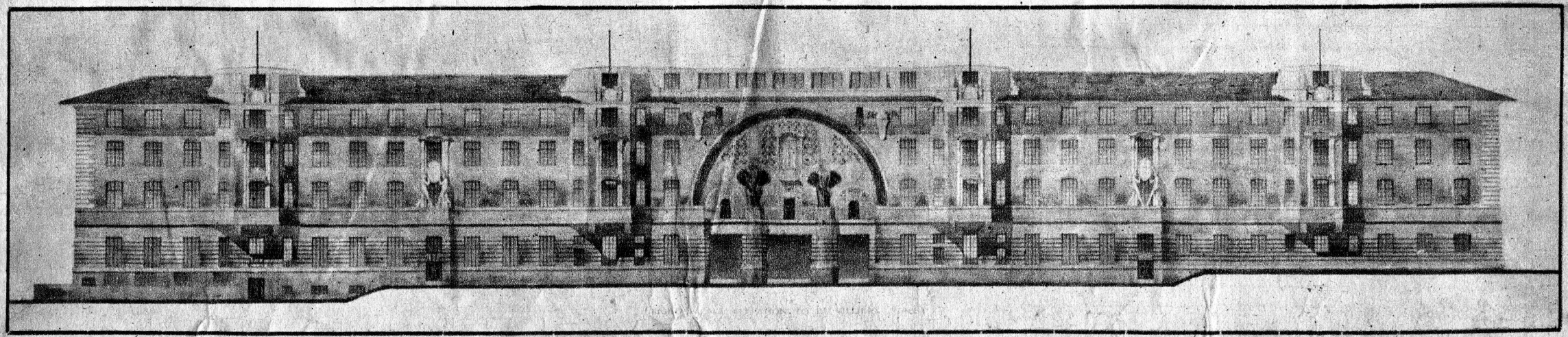
