
# **Accountable Manager 139.02.5**

### **POWERS AND DUTIES**

- •To ensure that all activities are according to requirements of this part.
- •Has unrestricted access to work or activities of employees or contractors to AD.
- •Has full rights of consultation with any such person in respect of compliance.
- •Has power to order cessation of any activity in non-compliance.
- •Duty to liaise with Commissioner regarding manners of compliance.

Also have a Competent Person responsible for Quality Control, and Aerodrome Manager and Traffic Service personnel.





# **Aerodrome Operator**

139.02.19(3) c: From 1/1/2003 is responsible for monitoring AC noise on and in the vicinity of the AD.

139.02.19(3) d: Is responsible to maintain flying discipline on and in the vicinity of the AD if the ATSU is not in operation.

139.02.20: Establish procedures to ensure that any works on AD do not endanger aircraft operations.

139.02.25: Shall establish and maintain an inspection program including procedures to ensure compliance by AD personnel.

139.02.25: May alter boundary of restricted area


139.02.27: May apply markings and notices to demarcate and restrict vehicle movement on apron.

139.02.30: Shall prevent any construction of facilities which has adverse effect on navaids or ATSU



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## The Right Of CAA To Inspect



### 139.01.7:

Shall permit authorized person to perform inspections -includes inspection of documents

### 139.01.8:

Authorized person may suspend licence if:

- •licence holder fails to comply with notification of noncompliance within 30 days;
- •is prevented to carry out safety inspection;
- •suspension is necessary in the interest of aviation safety.
- •Is denied access to aerodrome
