

## **Movement Of Aircraft And Vehicles**

### 139.01.12:

No person shall move an aircraft in the restricted area, except on a runway or taxiway, unless on direction of the AD operator. (On runway and taxiway on direction of ATSU)

### 139.01.14:

The AD operator may direct movement of aircraft or vehicles in the restricted area and, may have it moved by other means in case of failure to comply with such direction.

### 139.01.17:

The speed limit on the apron is 30km/h.



### VEHICLE CONTROL. Doc9137-an/898

- No vehicle in maneuvering area without RT
- AD operator to control vehicles by:
  - vehicle passes
  - Ensure presence of RT in relevant vehicles
  - Ensure drivers has RT training
  - Ensure drivers know airport
  - Ensure airport plan is displayed in cab of all vehicles
  - Unless exempted ensure vehicles has markings and lighting as per Annex 14 Chapter 6
- AD operator is responsible for regulating traffic on apron

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# **Parking**

### 139.01.18 (1):


The aircraft operator shall shall park at position required by AD operator.

### 139.01.18 (2):

No person shall move an aircraft from position on apron unless approved by AD operator.

### 139.01.20:

The AD operator may direct movement of vehicles on the apron or to be moved from the apron and may have it removed if failure to comply with such direction.





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# **Points Of Entry**

### 139.01.13:

No person, aircraft or vehicle may enter or leave the restricted area except at points established by the AD operator for such purpose.

### 139.01.15:

No person, except those carried in aircraft, (dis)embarking passengers, and aircraft operators shall have access to the apron unless approved by the AD operator.

- •No aircraft or vehicle shall be moved onto the apron unless approved by AD operator.
- •The AD operator shall determine procedures according to which permission to have access to the apron shall be granted.
