


# The open access publishing landscape

In 2020 there were an estimated 2.2 million subscription and 0.8 million pay-to-publish gold open access articles published worldwide.


South Africa landscape:

- Accelerated growth in open access publication in the last five years
- In the past two years, South African research output of the OA type has increased more substantially than in prior years



- Gold OA articles in fully gold OA journals
- Subscription articles (mostly in hybrid journals)



#### Gold open access at Elsevier

- Elsevier published 81,000 pay-topublish gold open access articles in 2020
- Annual growth of 65% on the previous year

- Difficult to validate reproducibility during peer • review






