- equipment and labour necessary for making the bricks on the site and will be paid at the rate of £-.-. per 1000 bricks; for all bricks made by him and approved of as before mentioned in Claus (2). The bricks will be accepted by the local authority at the brickmaking site and they will do all necessary cartage to the building site.
- - (a) Sleeping accommodation for two Natives at the brickmaking site,
 - (b) Not less than No. 1 E.C. each for whites and each 9 Natives. E.C. to be erected on site. A daily pail removal service to be given free of cost.
 - (c) The local authority to provide suitable sleeping commodation for the Native employees who will not exceed 28 (twenty eight) in number.
 - (d) The local authority must provide an adequate supply of water for the works and for drinking purposes at the brickmaking site.
