Bottle No. 1 (Plates of metal) weight 7.605 ounces including  
adhering clay.

" No. 2 Spiral "necklace" and lily shaped flowers or  
petals weight 21.483 ounces.

The pottery beads in same bottle were not  
weighed.

" No. 3 Spiral "necklace" and arm bands weight 9.395  
ounces also contained some wire flattened as  
though drawn through oblong orifice with  
rounded corners.

Separate lot of spirals much corroded, in cardboard box  
weight .432 ounce.
