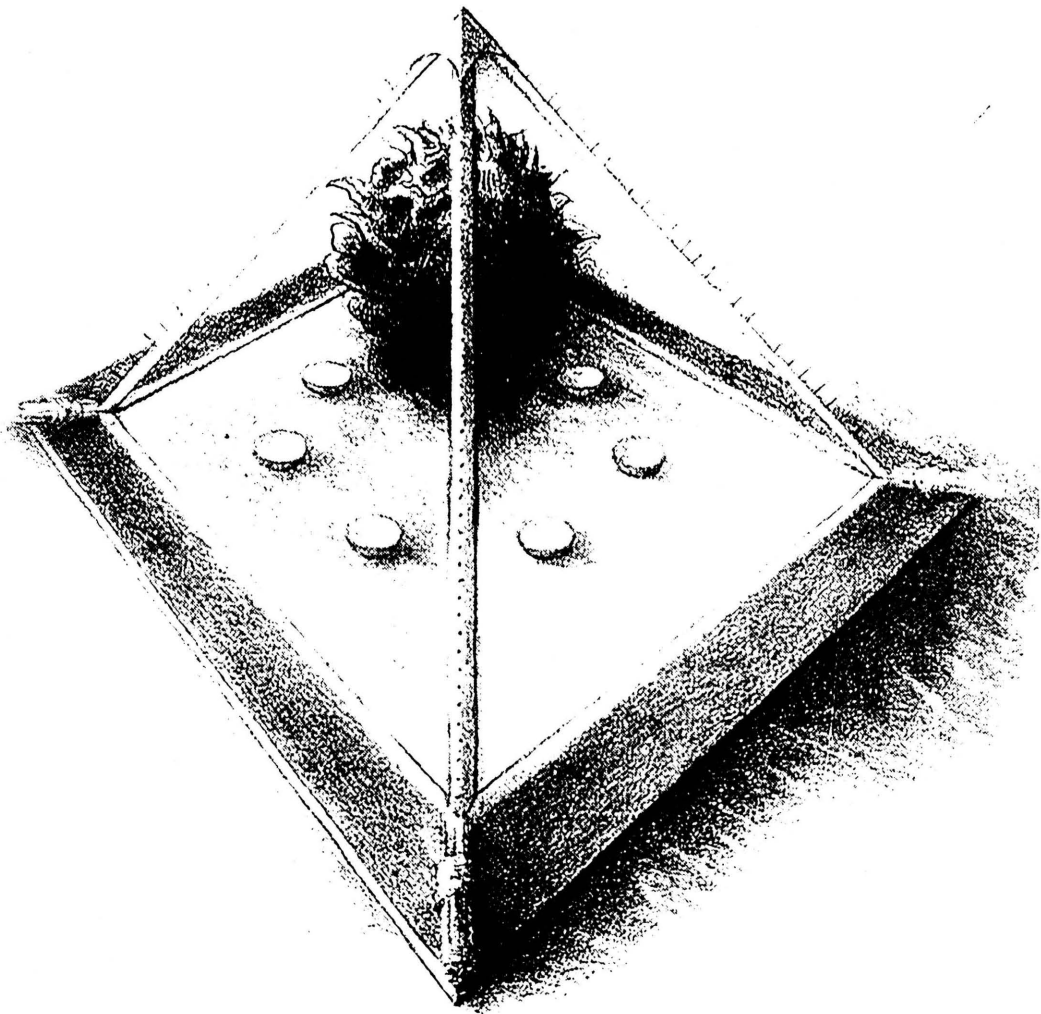


South African Journal of Art History

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To better assist the editorial team with the task of compiling the SAJAH in good time, all contributors are requested to produce their manuscripts in the format set out in this edition, viz.: two columns, with a left margin of 3 cm; a right margin of 3 cm; a top margin of 2.5 cm; and a bottom margin of 2 cm. All text should be in single spacing.

Each article must include a short abstract of no more than 250 words, written in English but preferably with a translation in Afrikaans. The abstract(s) should be in Times New Roman font set at pitch 10. The main body of the text should be in Times New Roman font set at pitch 12. The endnotes, which should immediately follow the main body of text, should be in Times New Roman font set at pitch 10. Finally, the source list should be in Times New Roman font, set at pitch 12.
