Among others, he was elected as Exceptional Young Researcher (UP) in 2009, and as Researcher of the Year (Faculty) both in 2009 and 2013.

Prof Naidoo has been serving as an expert committee member of the Medicines Control Council (MCC) since 2003 and has been a full member of the Council since 2010. He also currently serves as Chairperson of the Educational Committee of the South African Veterinary Council (SAVC).

Prof Naidoo has supervised a large number of master's and doctoral students to completion. He has published extensively, both in peer-reviewed journals and book chapters.
