

# MATERIALITY

## NATURAL



**STONE**  
The **narrative** and **material** characteristics of natural stone will be utilized to create a connection with nature as well as provide inherent mass as a thermal design strategy.



**ON-SITE CLAY AND SOIL**  
One-side walls will be used in multiple ways during the construction of the building will be utilized where additional **connection** is needed.



**TIMBER**  
Timber will be used in multiple ways in **intimate spaces** in order to express its biophilic qualities and affiliation with nature.



**VEGETATION**  
Facade greening and productive green walls will be employed as fundamental tools to establish a **physical link with nature**.



## SYNTHETIC



**STEEL**  
The **recycled** qualities of steel as a **narrative device** will be implemented to create an effective narrative with the synthetic nature of materials. The steel members will be acid-washed and painted to externally undergo processes of weathering to indicate the *passus* of time.



**POLYCARBONATE SHEETING**  
Val and inner sheets made of polycarbonate will be applied to **concrete**. **Let's be defined** on creating the building while simultaneously **holding formwork** and **protecting** the **concrete** from harsh weathering. **Let's be defined** that will be applied in floor slabs, roof and beam structures, foundations and retaining substructures.



**CONCRETE**  
Concrete is a **low maintenance** and **robust** material that will be applied in floor slabs, roof and beam structures, foundations and retaining substructures.



**BRICK**  
Brick will be implemented for wall structures throughout the building and will be given a **vernacular**, **decorative**, **hinged** **state** in order to create a **complementary contrast** with the smooth, all-in-one internal spaces with the natural colour and properties of the brick walls exposed.







**PERMEABLE PAVEMENT**  
Permeable concrete paving will be implemented for **external surfaces** including parking, roads and pedestrian routes in order to provide a hard surface to support vehicles and pedestrians in traffic while simultaneously allowing for vegetation and grasses to grow in between the pavers. It will facilitate the process of **filtering storm water** through suspended soils as well as minimizing the effects of erosion.




**BIO-CONCRETE**  
Bio-concrete is composed of a natural concrete layer that is made of conventional carbonated concrete together with magnesium-phosphate cement and then covered by a protective layer from pebbles, water damage. In the contrary, the **bio-concrete** layer has the capacity to capture rainwater and retain it in order to have an intermittent coating layer with a reverse waterproofing purpose that allows water and moisture to gather on and **enable biological growth of organisms** (Brownell, 2013).







