CORRESPONDENCE_

Received a letter from DESCOM regarding the use of courts in repression.

Received a letter of invitation from AZAFO.

Received a letter of invitation from CASSA.

Received a letter of thanks from Mrs. Tsotsobe regarding her sons funeral.

Received a letter from ASRC indicating that they want to affiliate.

RECEIVED a letter from BLACK_SASSH regarding their observer status.

MATTERS ARISING FROM CORRESPONDENCE

BLACK SASH was welcomed as observers in the UDF. General Council meeting.

AZAFO's letter of invitation was not acceptable by the General Council.

The meeting agreed to participate with AZAPC for tactical reasons.

It was further agreed that organisations must take initiatives in organising for National Days.

FATIFICATION OF MINUTES OF GENERAL COUNCIL 25 02 84

The minutes were read and ratified.

It was further agreed that the executive should get to the affiliates to inform them about the General Council meeting.

REPORTS FROM AFFILIATES

Only three (3) reports were received. These reports were from RUSAS, DESCOM and JODAC.

It was noted that non receiving of reports makes it difficult for the office to keep in contact with affiliates.

Affiliates in their report should focus on the organisation's work in taking up the UDF campaigns.

Format for the report should be developed by executive.

SECRETARIAL REPORT

It was mentioned in the secretarial report that Cde. Murphy Morobs is appointed as MSC coordinator.

MSC committe held a workshop on the MSC.

Grisis in the Pretoria schools reported, it was mentioned that the situation is worsening.

UDF training committee is planning a workshop for civic associations on the 27 to the 29th April 1984, at DAIESIDE.

No 7 8/4/87 Explanation was given about the UDF individuals merit in the Pretoria school boycott by M. Chikane. It was apparent that this intervention created serious problems. After serious discussion on this it was resolved that local organisations should discuss this issue among themselves rather than debate this in the UDF general council meeting.

1/10/1

It was stressed that UDF should respect other organisations and their role.

To avoid further confusion UDF personalities should identify themselve and make it clear on whose behalf they speak. This is necessary so as to avoid confusion about the role of the UDF.

Commission to be established to investigate this issue - M. Chikane, F Chikane and appointed CCSAS member will be the coordinatores of this commission.

MILLION SIGNATUTE CAMPAIGN

The coordinator reported on the MSC. spoke of the problems faced by (a) MSC committee

- (b) Affiliates.
- (c) Activists.

A comprehensive programme of action is being developed.

A signature blitz will be held on 28 April in Johannesburg. This would link up with May Day. Over 200 activists are expected to participate in the blitz. All organisations are encouraged to take part in this blitz.

On 26 April at 5pm Khotso House there will be a briefing session on the blitz.

Blitz should take place in as many areas as possible in the TVI Organisations should take the active and consult with the MSC committee for assistance.

CONSTITUTION AND ELECTIONS

At present the TIC conducted a house to house meetings with influential people, media blitzes to convince people not to vote.

July August agitation campaign to convince people not to vote.

Embark on a programme in the rural areas.

Constitution affects all communities therefore it is not sufficient for only TIC and Anti P. C. to be working on this area.

The executive will link at ways and means for other organisations to take up the campaigns.

CONSCRIPTION CONMITTEES

Reported that only four people attended the conscription committee.

Conscription committee should set up a meeting with present coordinating committees among the youth and students groups to get assistance from them.

Conscription Committee shoud try and make contact with all organisation in the UDF.

Noted that while conscription affects youth it will be a crucial factor in the election therefore it does affect the adult population. Thus all organisations should be taking up this issue, not only the youth groups.

Date of conscription meeting is 25 April at 5 30 pm.

After a long absence, the president was welcomed by the General council of the UDF. She said that she hope that in the future she will be in the position to speak to us all again.

RESTRUCTURING OF UDF

Frank Chikane reported that on the executive recommendations regarding the restructuring of the UDF. This was accepted in principle.

FINANCES

Treasurers were not present to give the report. The house expressed its concern about their absence.

Also concern was epressed about the absence of the executive members.

Noted that the festival committee have not sent a financial statement. Concern was expressed about the Festival committee It was decided that the Festival committee should submit a financial statement to the next General Council Meeting.

UDF NEWS

Could not be discussed in details because the financial statement was not submitted.

Affiliates were encouraged to join the media committee.

GENERAL

DESCOM gave a brief report on repression in South Africa and heighlighted the fact that the courts are used more and more in repression. It was agreed that legal affairs would work closely with DESCOM in highlighting and campaigning against repression.


These are but a few of the problems facing the MSC
