on Heraldry. Of course the Lion Rampant within a red double tressure flying combe flying first used by Alex III. 1249 1286 is the Royal Arms of Scotland & the personal of the King. Many Scots fly this thinking it is the Flag of Scotland - which is the St. Andrews Cross. Scots in P.F. were very angry once when I mentioned this. Tel "He who scampers his Province Arms loses his head" is recorded in Mackenzie's "Scenes of Heraldry" 1880.
