## Stokes, B

Brian Stokes graduates as architect at Pretoria University in 1974, and starts his own practise, which presently operates as Brian Stokes, Moolman & Marais in George, Upington, Mosselbaai and Pretoria.

He is both architect and landscape-architect, and practices at the interface between the two disciplines.
