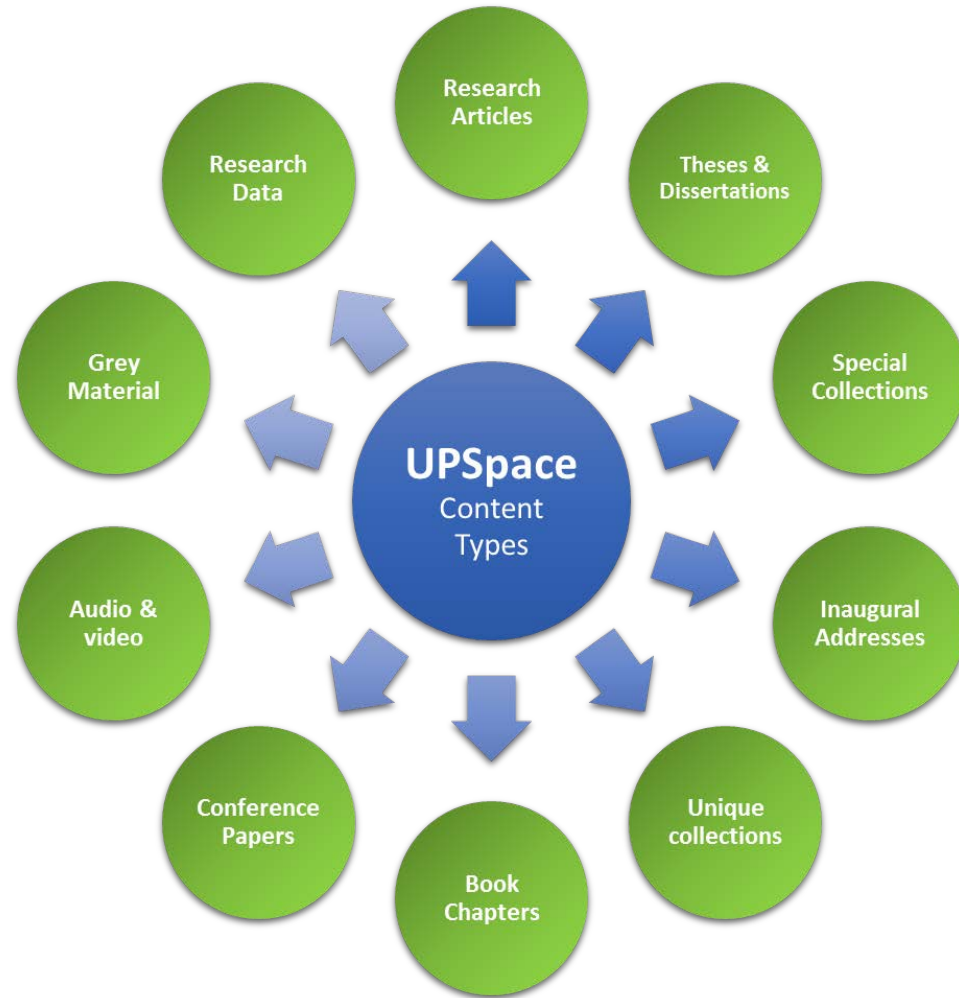

# What is Open Access?

- Open access is the practice of making digital scholarly material available freely via the Internet.
- “By open access, we mean its immediate, free availability on the public internet, permitting any users to read, download, copy, distribute, print, search or link to the full text of these articles, crawl them for indexing, pass them as data to software or use them for any other lawful purpose, without financial, legal, or technical barriers other than those inseparable from gaining access to the internet itself. The only constraint on reproduction and distribution, and the only role for copyright in this domain, should be to give authors control over the integrity of their work and the right to be properly acknowledged and cited.” (Budapest definition of Open Access)



# Open Access and types

- Gold route Open Access
  - All journal articles are open access and freely available
- Green route Open Access
  - Publishers allow to be in repositories and there are restrictions
- Hybrid Open Access
  - Both green and gold
- Grey literature
  - Unpublished materials (Theses and Dissertations)
  - Technical reports

# Benefits

- **Researchers**
  - Increased visibility of research output
  - Increased impact of publications
  - Helps researchers manage any requirements of funding bodies for publications to be made available in a repository (NRF ratings)
- **Institution**
  - Increase the visibility and prestige of institution
  - Content is readily searchable both locally and globally
- **Community**
  - Aids in the public understanding of research endeavours and activities

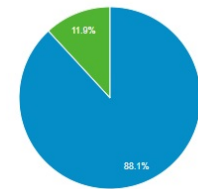

**Abstract:**  
Two closely related ophiostomatoid fungi, *Knoxdaviesia capensis* and *K. proteae*, inhabit the fruiting structures of certain *Protea* species indigenous to southern Africa. Although *K. capensis* occurs in several *Protea* hosts, *K. proteae* is confined to *P. repens*. In this study, the genomes of *K. capensis* CBS139037 and *K. proteae* CBS140089 are determined. The genome of *K. capensis* consists of 35,537,816 bp assembled into 29 scaffolds and 7940 predicted protein-coding genes of which 6192 (77.98 %) could be functionally classified. *K. proteae* has a similar genome size of 35,489,142 bp that is comprised of 133 scaffolds. A total of 8173 protein-coding genes were predicted for *K. proteae* and 6093 (74.55 %) of these have functional annotations. The GC-content of the *K. proteae* genome is 52.8 %.
