




Research Data Management Roadmap (2014 - Current)

- 2014 Proposed new University policy on RDM sent through to University Executive for review
- 2015 Task team to investigate infrastructure needed for RDM across the university
- 2017 RDM policy was adopted and approved by Senate
- 2016 2018 Investigation of Data Repository Systems
- 2019 Implementation of Research Data Management Readiness Training Toolkit
- 2020 Launch of the UP Research Data Repository (Figshare)
- 2021 Dimensions: the State of Open Data 2021 survey
- 2021/2022 NSTF Awards Finalists
- 2022 Love Data Publishing at UP2022 seminar series

Open Science taxonomy described by FOSTER Plus. 23




RDM Strategy

- UP Research Data Management (RDM) covers the entire research data lifecycle – essentially everything that a researcher might do with their data. This includes collection, storage, curation, publication, archiving and re-use
- Good data management is fundamental to the research process. It is a dynamic process that must be carefully considered throughout the course of a research project, from the planning stage through to final publication of results





Communication Plan

- Promote Figshare through campus publications
- Development of a Marketing Video in collaboration with Dept of University Relations
- Personalised e-mail from Vice Principal for Research and Innovation's office to UP researchers and postgraduate students
- Market the system via roadshows to all 9 faculties done by Library Services, ITS together & Vice Principal: Research and Innovation
- This included explanation of the whole research ecosystem that support the research process including Figshare, UPSpace, etc... how this align with the UP RDM Policy



Implementation of Figshare

- Training of admin users
- Determine quota (size) of uploading data per user (ITS)
- Determine the name of the Repository (RDM Steering Committee)
- Planning of a Roadshow to Faculties (completed)
- Planning of training of researchers & support staff (RDM Readiness Training Toolkit) (continuous)
- Compile training material for researchers & library staff (in process)
- Smaller customisations such as specifying Terms, Licenses, Helpdesk Links/email, and Libguides (completed)
- Inhouse training for Faculty Research Coordinators (in process)



Maintenance: Figshare Research Data Repository at UP

- Technical kick-off meeting between the UP RDM Task Team with Kay Lino (Figshare) on 21 September 2018
- Setup and Configuration of Figshare Solution in the testing environment (completed)
- Teething problems: Figshare, Library IT, UP ITS
- Sustainability & Staff Development Capacity CoPs, i.e. Digital Preservation Consortium



DMP Tool: Implementation in Progress

- UP libraries has developed a DMPTool for postgraduate students and researchers
- ✓ assist students and researchers to create Data Management Plans
- ✓ The DMP requirement is expressed in the ETD policy, Research papers policy, APC policy and will be in the iGAPP Research Data Management policy
- UP Customised DMP Tool (to be implemented by Dec 2022)
- ✓ Provides a web-based interface for completing DMPs, and include funder templates for most research funders and accompanying guidance relating to each funder's data policies and requirements



UP Research Data Repository (Figshare)

- All research data (normally processed data) and its accompanying metadata must be published in the UP open data repository (database), or an accredited disciplinespecific repository, where available
- In some instances access to data should be embargoed or restricted due to ethical and legal reasons
- Researcher should send link of a dataset deposited in an external repository to the rdm@up.ac.za
- Metadata training for depositors to align UP Data Repository & the SA SDGs hub



Research Data Management – NSTF-South32 Awards

- The call for nominations 05 November 2021 for NSTF-South32 Awards 2021/2022
- Recognizes the value of open data (datasets) for public good, dataset that is of national interest
- The DLS Open Scholarship unit, nominated two leading researchers
- Two researchers have successfully and continued to archive their research data in the UP-Research Data Repository

UP RDM Achievements to date

Roll-out of RDM across all 9 Faculties

✓ Roadshows are currently being conducted to Faculties where the RDM process, RDM Intranet Toolkit FAIR principles are presented to staff

• RDM team assembled by UP Libraries, since 2019

✓ An RDM coordinating team (working with Scholarly Communications, Digital scholarship & UP Libraries IT units). Currently we have 3 full-time staff members that that support researchers (Senior Open Scholarship Coordinator, RDM Curator, Metadata Specialist)

• Continuous upskilling of Library Information Specialists:

✓ Information specialists (subject specialist librarians) attended a two-day workshop on RDM on 3-4 March 2020, which was facilitated by an RDM expert from University of Edinburgh, a follow-up 3 day workshop in 2023

• Workflow on the UP Figshare Repository:

✓ 3,588 datasets......1,081,353 views88,555 downloads


