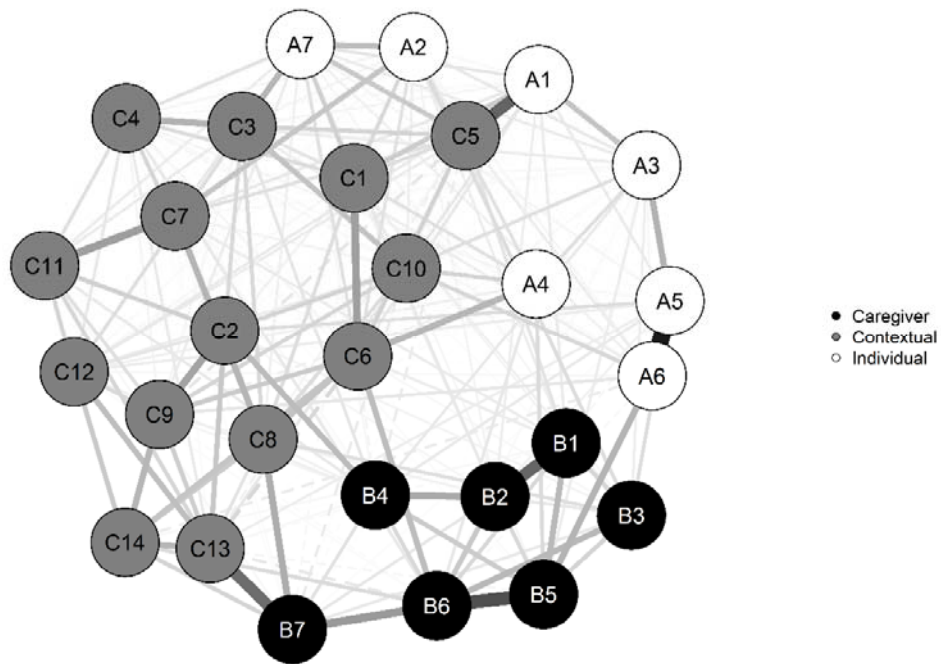


Figure S1b. Country-level network model for South Africa across age groups.
