ABSTRACT

CAASA came into existence in the final year of World War II and has been a pivotal organisation in the development of the Commercial and General aviation sector over the past 75 years and counting. We bring industry needs into the regulator's decision making and government's policy development. We have seen the movement and regulatory development through the major aviation milestones including the jet age and soon we believe space travel bringing in recently the advent of space weather and significant rise of unmanned aviation.
