



FIG. 2.—Method of collecting faeces.









FIG. 3.—Mature larva of *Haemonchus contortus*.

FIG. 5.—Mature larva of Oesophagostomum columbianum.






FIG. 6.—Mature larva of Bunostomum trigonocephalum.




FIG. 8.—Trichostrongylus instabilis.




FIG. 9.—Oesophagostomum columbianum.





FIG. 11.-Sheep showing symptoms of "reksiekte."
