CONTRIBUTIONS : Epidemiological studies on a wide variety of helminths; developed some of first anthelmintics, eg 'Nodular worm remedy' and 'Tetram', and a blowfly remedy; in 1934 the 1st edition of his classic book 'Veterinary Helminthology and Entomology' was published, which subsequently became the international standard textbook for tuition of these subjects; in 1945 he resigned his official post and founded the well known Agricura Laboratories which manufactured remedies for the control of parasitic infestations and diseases of livestock for many years.
