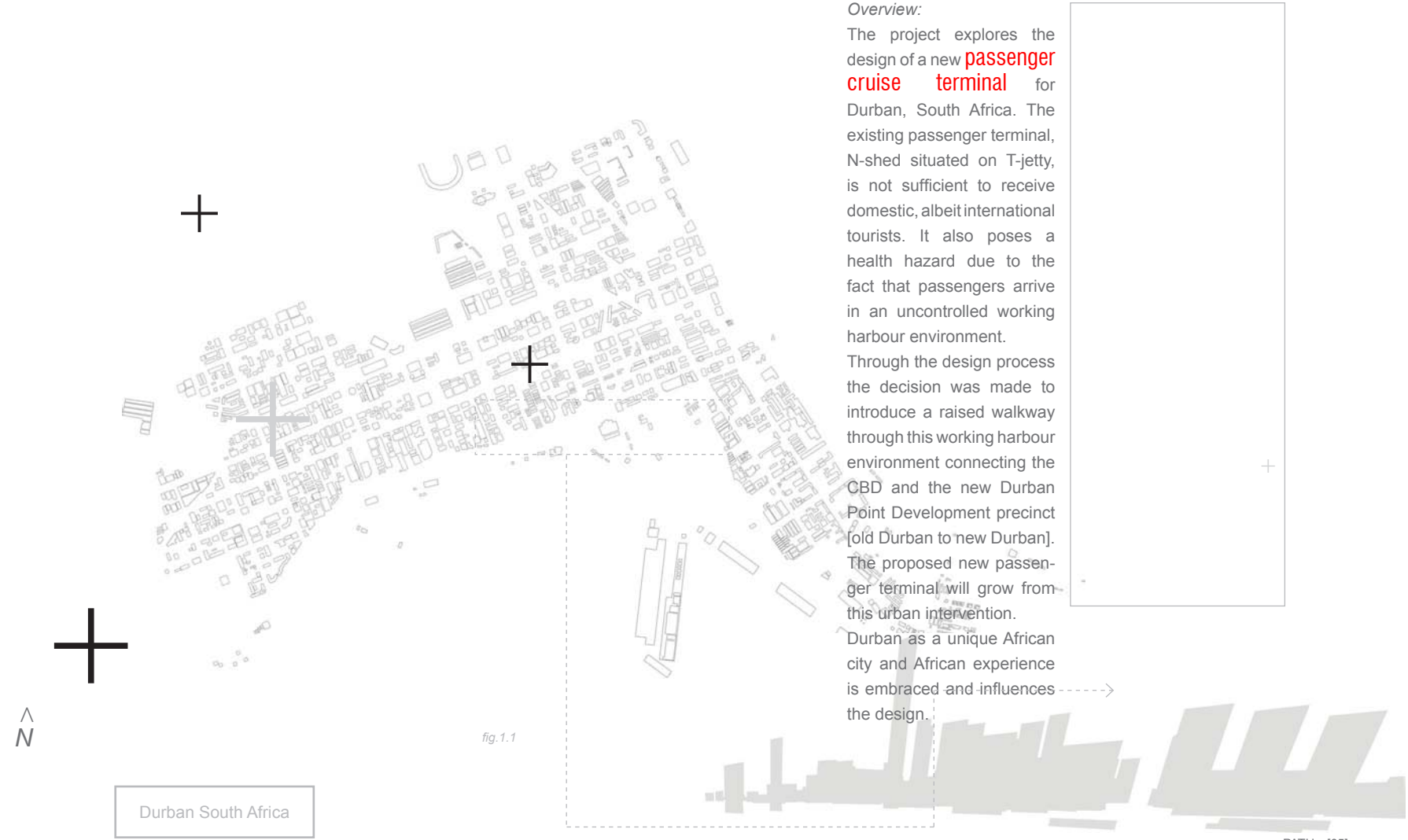

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Overview:

The project explores the design of a new **passenger cruise terminal** for Durban, South Africa. The existing passenger terminal, N-shed situated on T-jetty, is not sufficient to receive domestic, albeit international tourists. It also poses a health hazard due to the fact that passengers arrive in an uncontrolled working harbour environment.

Through the design process the decision was made to introduce a raised walkway through this working harbour environment connecting the CBD and the new Durban Point Development precinct [old Durban to new Durban]. The proposed new passenger terminal will grow from this urban intervention.

Durban as a unique African city and African experience is embraced and influences the design.
