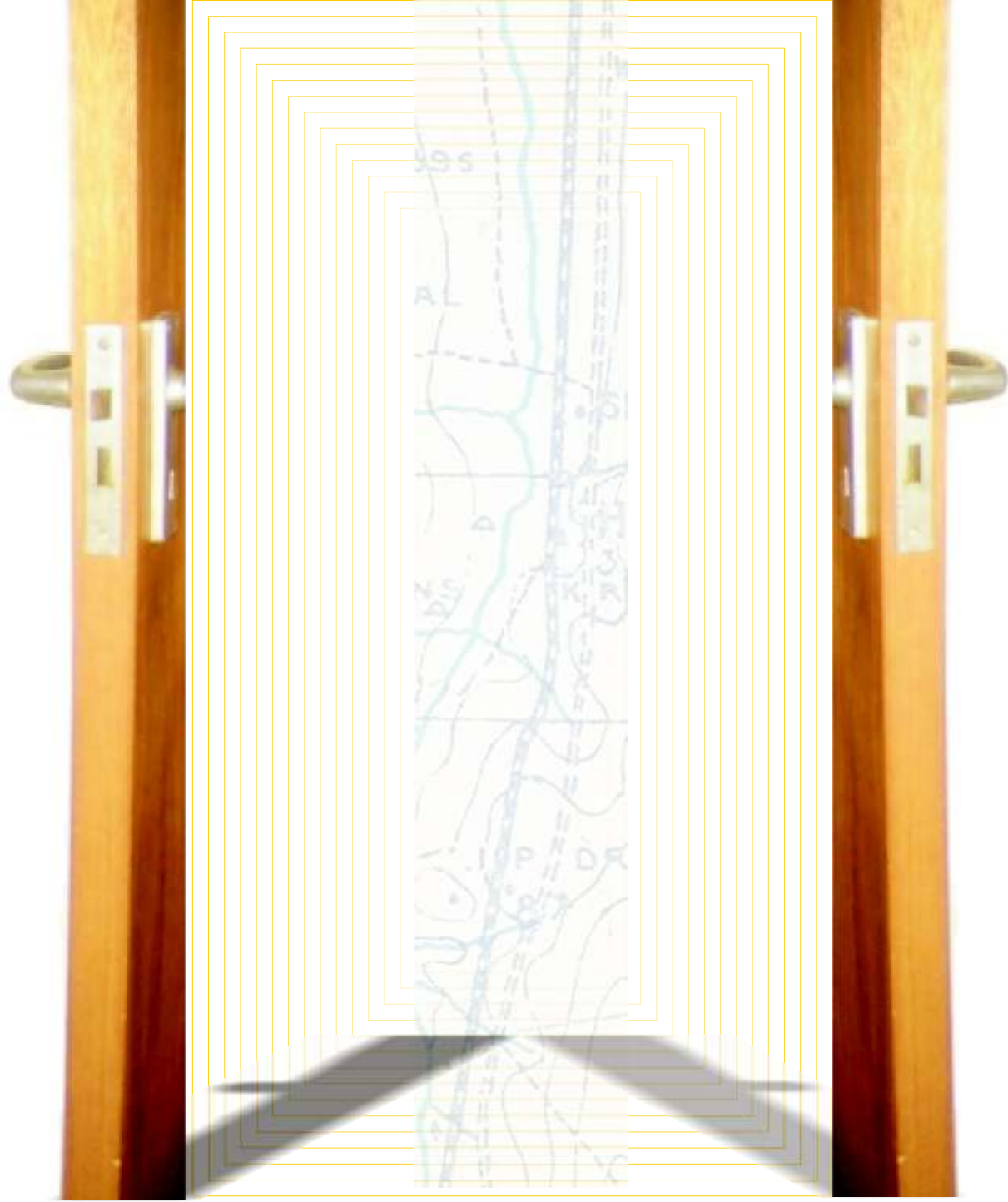
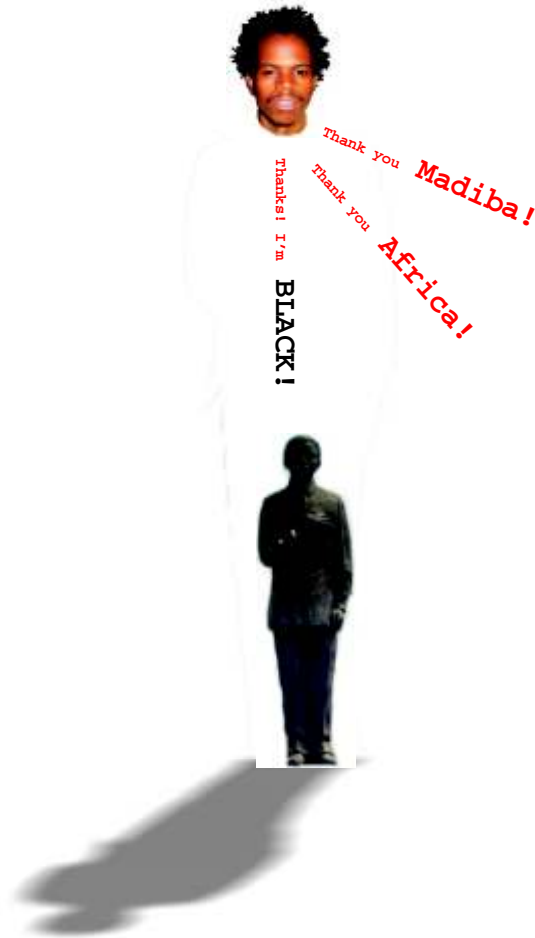

Am I confused?

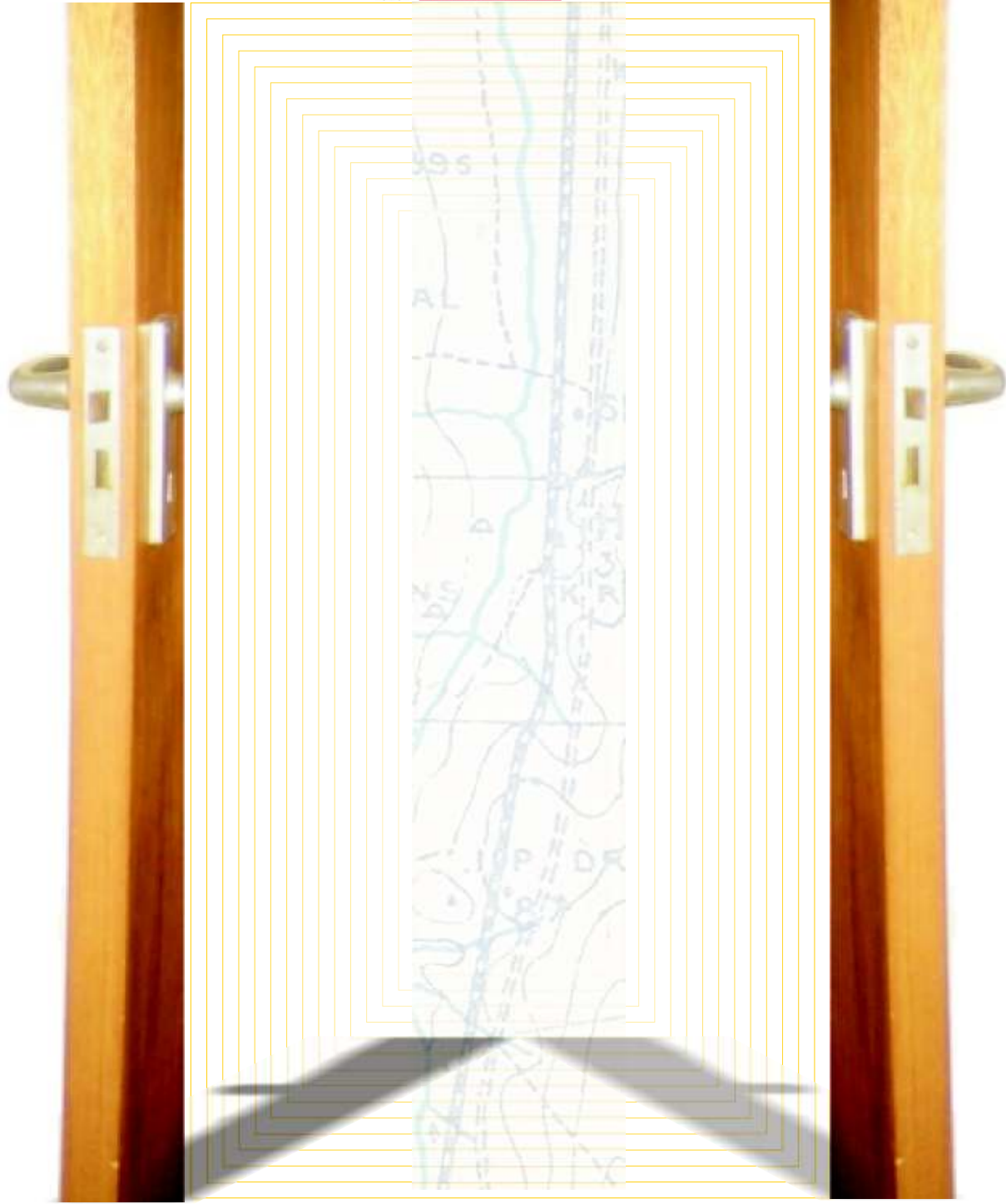
A mme ke rapela modimo wa ba Juta?
