Faculty collaborates with Tshwane Speaker's Office to expose learners to Veterinary Science

The learners were also taken on a short tour of the faculty and their visit to the faculty's Skills Lab in particular was very popular among the group members. It was clear that the visit to the Faculty was a whole new experience to the girls. "The girls were very happy and they mentioned how interesting the veterinary field is which they knew little or nothing about", Ms Malatsi said.

She added that the feedback from the learners was very positive about where they were and the opportunities they discovered and did not know exist. "This was a very informative and eye opening session, not only for the girls but also for our support staff that accompanied them", she said.
