

Voortrekker Mausoleum Decision

Capetown, Tuesday.

The Historical Monuments Commission, of which the Speaker of the House of Assembly, E. G. Jansen, is chairman, at a meeting in the House to-day, decided on the form of the monument which is to be erected to the memory of the Voortrekkers, and appointed Mr. G. Moerdyk, of Pretoria, the foremost architect of Dutch churches in South Africa, as architect of the memorial.

This will take the form of an old Greek mausoleum.

The Commission has not yet decided on the site.

The Voortrekker Centenary will be celebrated in 1938, but it will not be possible for the monument to be completed by that date and therefore the Commission has decided that the Centenary celebrations shall take the form of the laying of the foundation stone of the monument.
