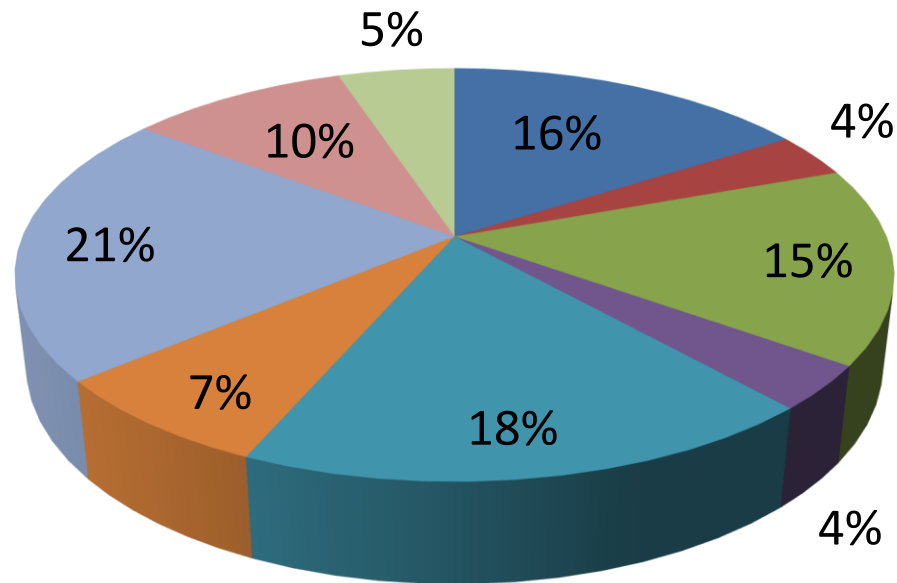


Student attendance per Faculty
