8. FINANCE8.1 FINANCIAL REPORT

A FINANCIAL REPORT AS AT 31 DECEMBER 1983 WAS PRESENTED BY N. PAHAD. THE UDF TRANSVAAL HAS A DEBT OF R32 000. IT WAS DECIDED THAT LETTERS OF APPEAL SHOULD BE SENT TO AFFILIATES THAT HAVE NOT SUBMITTED THE R100 00 CONTRIBUTION. THE SECRETARIES WERE ASKED TO READ OUT THE NAMES OF THESE ORGANIZATIONS AT THE NEXT MEETING.

8.2 FUND RAISING

- (a) AN ALL - DAY FESTIVAL IS BEING PLANNED IN ORDER TO RAISE FUNDS. THE FESTIVAL WOULD BE HELD AT FUND VALLEY ON 4 03 84. AFFILIATES WERE REQUESTED TO ASSIST THE FESTIVAL COMMITTEE WHICH MEETS EVERY TUESDAYS AT THE UDF OFFICE.
- (b) IT WAS SUGGESTED THAT AFFILIATES SCREEN FILMS IN ORDER TO RAISE MONEY FOR THE UNITED DEMOCRATIC FRONT.

9. COMRADE GUMEDE'S TV APPEARANCE

MR. C. SALOOJEE SAID THAT COMRADE GUMEDE'S INTERVIEW WAS DISTORTED BY SABC TV. IT WAS DECIDED THAT THE N.E.C. ADOPTS A CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ITS MEMBERS IN ORDER TO AVOID SUCH PROBLEMS IN FUTURE. THE N.E.C. SHOULD ALSO RECOMMEND A CODE OF CONDUCT FOR AFFILIATE ORGANISATIONS TOWARDS EACH OTHER.

10. COLOURED AND INDIAN REFERENDUM.

OF THE TWENTY FIVE ORGANIZATIONS REPRESENTED AT THE MEETING TWELVE WERE IN FAVOUR OF A BOYCOTT. TEN WERE IN FAVOUR OF A NO VOTE. TWO ORGANIZATIONS SAID THAT THEY WERE OPEN AND ONE ORGANIZATION ABSTAINED.

THE GENERAL SECRETARY REPORT ON THE PORT ELIZABETH CONFERENCE WAS READ TOGETHER WITH THE CONFERENCE RECOMMENDATIONS.

DELEGATES APPEALED TO THE HOUSE TO ADOPT AN OPEN MIND ALTHOUGH PEOPLE HAVE MANDATES FROM THEIR ORGANIZATIONS. IT WAS ALSO SAID THAT INSTEAD OF DEBATING THE TWO EXTREME POSITIONS, DELEGATES SHOULD APPLY THEMSELVES TO PROPOSING COMPROMISES, IN ORDER TO ARRIVE AT A SOLUTION WHICH WOULD BE ACCEPTABLE TO ALL AFFILIATES.

IT WAS SAID THAT WE MUST DEMONSTRATE THAT THE GOVERNMENT RULES BY FORCE DESPITE ITS TALK OF REFORM. COLOURED AND INDIAN PEOPLE SHOULD BE SEEN TO BE REJECTING THE CONSTITUTION. THE CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE CONSTITUTION MUST BEGIN IMMEDIATELY. IT WAS ALSO SAID THAT ANY COMPROMISE POSITION SHOULD HAVE THE POTENTIAL OF HALTING THE FORMATION OF THE COLOURED AND INDIAN PARLIAMENTS.

A SPEAKER POINTED OUT THAT THE CISKEI REFERENDUM IN 1981 WAS IGNORED BY THE PEOPLE. IT WAS ALSO SAID THAT WE WOULD NOT NECESSARILY EMBARRASS—THE GOVERNMENT.

3/ BY CASTING.....

BY CASTING A MASSIVE NO VOTE. A SPEAKER ALSO SAID THAT MANY COLOURED PEOPLE DO NOT POSSESS BOOK'S OF LIFE. IN THIS SITUATION CAMPAIGNING FOR A NO VOTE WOULD REQUIRE OF US TO ASK SUCH PEOPLE TO REGISTER AND THUS SUBJECT THEMSELVES TO RACE CLASSIFICATION.

TWO ALTERNATE POSITIONS WERE SUGGESTED :

- (a) UDF SHOULD MAKE A DEMAND FOR A NON - RACIAL REFERENDUM. THIS WOULD DIFFERENTIATE BETWEEN THE DEMAND MADE BY UDF AND THAT MADE BY THE LIKES OF RAJBANSI.
- (b) A DEMAND SHOULD BE MADE FOR AN INDIAN REFERENDUM AS CONDITIONS IN THIS COMMUNITY MILITATES FAVOURABLE FOR THIS CALL.

DUE TO LACK OF TIME THE DISCUSSION ON (a) AND (b) ABOVE WAS NOT ADEQUATE. FINALLY, THE HOUSE RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS :

WE, THE TRANSVAAL GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE UNITED DEMOCRATIC FRONT, NOTING

- (i) THAT NO CONSENSUS HAS BEEN ARRIVED AT IN THE TRANSVAAL AFTER WEEKS OF DISCUSSIONS AND CONSULTATIONS.
- (ii) THAT THE DEBATES HAS ALREADY TAKEN UP MUCH TIME AND ENERGY.
- (iii) THAT THE FRONT NEEDS TO DEMONSTRATE ITS ABILITY TO TAKE FIRM DECISIONS AND AVOID PARALYSIS.

THEREFORE RESOLVE:

- (i) THAT THE VOTING STATISTICS AND SUBSEQUENT DISCUSSIONS AND OPTIONS PRESENTED BE HANDED OVER TO THE N.E.C. FOR A DECISION, THIS DECISION BEING BINDING ON ALL AFFILIATES OF THE TRANSVAAL UNITED DEMOCRATIC FRONT.
- (ii) THAT THE N.E.C. MAKES EVERY ATTEMPT TO SEARCH FOR A SOLUTION THAT WOULD BE ACCEPTIBLE TO ALL AFFILIATES.

II. STATUS OF OBSERVERS AT GENERAL COUNCIL MEETINGS

IT WAS DECIDED THAT IN GENERAL COUNCIL OBSERVERS SHOULD NOT BE ALLOWED TO SPEAK. EXCEPTIONS WOULD BE MADE IN CASES WHERE OBSERVERS HAVE BEEN INVITED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN DELIBERATION ON PARTICULAR TOPICS.

12. GENERAL

12.1 IT WAS SUGGESTED THAT THE UDF SENDS TELEGRAMS TO THE U.K AND U.S.A. CONDEMNING ITS STAND ON THE WAR IN ANGOLA.

MEETING HELD ON THE 14 JANUARY 1984

I. NATIONAL CONFERENCE HELD ON THE 17 AND 18 DECEMBER 1984

THE NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE UNITED DEMOCRATIC FRONT DEALT WITH THE FOLLOWING ISSUES.

1. THE COLOURED AND INDIAN REFERENDUM.
2. MILITARY CONSCRIPTION.
3. THE MILLION SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN.

AFTER MUCH DELIBERATION ON THE TACTIC TO BE ADOPTED AS REGARDS THE COLOURED AND INDIAN REFERENDUM, THE CONFERENCE RESOLVED THAT :

- (a) THE UDF ALLOW ITS AFFILIATES FLEXIBILITY OF TACTICS TO SHOW REJECTION OF THE CONSTITUTION.
- (b) THAT THE REGIONS DISCUSS THE RECOMMENDATIONS AND GIVE FEEDBACK TO THE NATIONAL SECRETARIAT FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE N.E.C.

AN INPUT PAPER ON MILITARY CONSCRIPTION WAS DELIVERED. DUE TO A SHORTAGE OF TIME THIS ISSUE WAS NOT DEALT WITH ADEQUATELY. HOWEVER, THE CONFERENCE RECOMMENDED THAT THE MATTER BE DISCUSSED AT REGIONAL LEVEL.

IT WAS DECIDED THAT THE MILLION SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN WOULD BE LAUNCHED IN JANUARY 1984. THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF SIGNATURES TO BE COLLECTED BY THE TRANSVAAL REGION WOULD BE 300 000.

2. MILLION SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN

THIS CAMPAIGN WOULD BE LAUNCHED ON 22 JANUARY 1984 AT A RALLY IN SOSHANGUVE BY THE N.E.C. WHICH MEETS IN PRETORIA OVER THE SAME WEEKEND. THE OCCASION WOULD ALSO HIGHLIGHT THE CONTINUED DETENTION OF UDF PATRON FATHER SMANGALISO MKATCHWA. A COMMITTEE HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED TO CO-ORDINATE THIS CAMPAIGN IN THE TRANSVAAL. THE COMMITTEE MEETS ON WEDNESDAYS AT 5.30 PM AT THE UDF OFFICE. ALL ORGANISATIONS ARE WELCOMED TO SEND VOLUNTEERS TO JOIN THE COMMITTEE.

3. THE NORTHERN CAPE REGION

THIS REGION IS TO BE LAUNCHED ON THE 21 AND 22 JANUARY 1984 AT RALLIES TO BE HELD IN VRYBURG AND KIMBERLY.

4. FINANCE

THE R.E.C. HAS ADOPTED A FINANCIAL REPORT AS AT 31 DECEMBER 1983. THE REPORT INDICATES AN EXPENDITURE OF R80 000 AND THE AMOUNT OWING IS OVER R32 000.

Vaal Civic Association Report. 1984.01.14

1. BOPHELONG: This area is very active in the affairs of the Civic Association. A committee has been elected and a Youth Congress has been formed. Regular meetings are being held to ensure greater participation of the community.

2 Zone 7 Seokeng A working committee has been formed and is very busy on house-meetings and will arrange a meeting where the area committee will be elected. There is real interest in this area. The committee has 12 members.

3 Zone 12 Seokeng: A working committee of 7 members is busy mobilising in this area and expect to form and elect an area committee within the next three months.

4. Problems affecting Schools: The Zone 7 committee has organised a group of 20 parents to look into problems affecting Euston and Seokeng zones. Students who failed their internal exams have been turned away from Esokwazi and Tekelo Secondary Schools and some at Tshepo-Themba High School; and the latter is plagued by resignation of about ten teachers (this is forced resignation which is very rife in the Vaal). This ^{group} committee has managed to have the students re-admitted. Plans are afoot to form a parents' Action Committee and S.R.C. both in this area and the Bophelong & Baipatong area.

An appeal is therefore made to the U.D.F. to help orientate these committees in order to tackle School matters effectively. School inspectors in this area are real "bullies" and this needs attention. Parents need to know their rights in as far as school matters are concerned.

We wish to thank the members of the U.D.F. for their help from time to time, especially Comrade Curtis Nkomo who is an inspiration, to the Vaal Civic Association

A. INTRODUCTION

THE CONTENT OF THE SIGNATURE FORM CAN BE SUMMARISED AS FOLLOWS:

1. REJECTION OF THE CONSTITUTION ACT.
2. REJECTION OF THE KOORNHOF LAWS.
3. SUPPORT FOR THE UNITED DEMOCRATIC FRONT.
4. COMMITMENTS TO THE CREATION OF A NON - RACIAL DEMOCRATIC SOUTH AFRICA.

IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE BASIC WORDING AN ORGANIZATION OR AREA MAY ADD ONE ADDITIONAL DEMAND. THIS ADDITIONAL DEMAND MAKES IT POSSIBLE FOR THE CAMPAIGN TO BE LINKED TO LOCAL STRUGGLES.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT THIS IS NOT A PETITION BUT RATHER A SIGNATURES CAMPAIGN. THIS IS BECAUSE IT IS NOT INTENDED THAT THESE SIGNATURES WOULD BE PRESENTED TO THE GOVERNMENT OR ANY OTHER AUTHORITY.

B. AIM

THE AIM OF THE CAMPAIGN IS TO COLLECT AT LEAST ONE MILLION SIGNATURES CONTRYWIDE. IN THIS REGARD, A MINIMUM OF 300,000 SIGNATURES WOULD HAVE TO BE COLLECTED IN THE TRANSVAAL REGION.

C. OBJECTIVES

THESE CAN BE CAREGORISED INTO EDUCATIVE, IDEOLOGICAL AND ORGANIZATIONAL OBJECTIVES.

1. EDUCATION AND AWARENESS

ALTHOUGH THE CAMPAIGN TO EDUCATE PEOPLE ABOUT THE CONSTITUTION ACT, KOORNHOF LAWS AND THE UDF HAS STARTED IN 1983. THE SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN WOULD ENSURE THAT PEOPLE'S AWARENESS IS FURTHER ENRICHED. THIS IS BECAUSE THERE WOULD BE DIRECT CONTACT BETWEEN THE ACTIVIST AND THE PERSON SIGNING. THUS THE CAMPAIGN WOULD ENSURE THAT AT LEAST ONE MILLION PEOPLE WOULD BE SPOKEN TO DIRECTLY ABOUT THE ISSUES.

2. IDEOLOGICAL

THE NUMBER OF SIGNATURES THAT ARE COLLECTED WOULD INDICATE CONCRETELY THE WIDESPREAD REJECTION OF BOTHA'S PLANS. IT WOULD ALSO SHOW THAT THE UDF'S SUPPORT IS ACTIVE AND WIDESPREAD.

IDEOLOGICAL GAINS COULD ALSO BE MADE AT THE LOCAL LEVEL. FOR EXAMPLE, UDF AFFILIATES IN SOWETO COULD COLLECT MORE SIGNATURES THAN THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE THAT VOTED IN THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ELECTIONS AND THEREBY CLAIM CREATER LECITIMACY THAN THE SOWETO COUNCIL.

3. ORGANIZATIONAL

THE MILLION SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN SHOULD ALSO BE AIMED AT CONSOLIDATING AND EXPANDING ORGANIZATION. THE MOMENTUM THAT HAD BEEN GENERATED BY THE ANTI - CC. CAMPAIGN CAN BE MAINTAINED AND CONSOLIDATED BY A VIGOROUS SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN.

LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS AND THEIR STRUGGLES CAN BE STRENGTHENED BY INCORPORATING A LOCAL DEMAND ON THE SIGNATURE FORM.

THIS CAMPAIGN ALSO MAKES IT POSSIBLE TO ENLIST THE ACTIVE INVOLVEMENT OF THE WIDE RANGE OF SUPPORTATIVE INDIVIDUALS AND ORGANIZATIONS.

D. SUGGESTED APPROACHES

THE APPROACH USED BY DIFFERENT ORGANIZATIONS AND AREAS WOULD HAVE TO BE TAILORED TO THEIR DIFFERING CONDITIONS. HERE WE MERELY PROVIDE BROAD GUIDELINES AND SUGGESTIONS.

1. TRAINING

THERE IS A NEED TO TRAIN VOLUNTEERS WHO WOULD BE ASSISTING IN THE COLLECTION OF SIGNATURES. THE TRAINING SHOULD COVER THE FOLLOWING ASPECTS:

- (a) ANALYSIS OF THE CONSTITUTION ACT.
- (b) ANALYSIS OF THE KOORNHOF LAWS.
- (c) THE NATURE, AIMS AND HISTORY OF THE UDF.
- (d) THE MEANING OF THE MILLION SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN.
- (e) PERSONNEL CONDUCT WHEN COLLECTING SIGNATURES.

2. HOUSE TO HOUSE VISITS

THE BEST WAY TO ACHIEVE THE ABOVE OBJECTIVES IS TO SPEAK TO PEOPLE DIRECTLY. THERE ARE NUMEROUS WAYS IN WHICH PEOPLE CAN BE SPOKEN TO, HOWEVER, SPEAKING TO PEOPLE IN THEIR HOUSES IS THE MOST EFFECTIVE WAY AND WOULD YIELD THE BEST RESULTS.

THIS DOES NOT PRECLUDE COLLECTING SIGNATURES IN CHURCHES, AT SOCCER STADIA, SHOPPING CENTRES, PUBLIC MEETINGS, ETC.

THE OBJECTIVES OF EDUCATION, HEIGHTENING AWARENESS AND ORGANIZING SHOULD BE UPPERMOST IN OUR MINDS WHENEVER SPEAKING TO PEOPLE.

3. PHASES AND PUBLICITY

THE MILLION SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN WAS LAUNCHED AT A RALLY IN SOSHANGUVE ON THE 22ND JANUARY 1984. ALREADY A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF PUBLICITY IS BUILT INTO THE CAMPAIGN, IT WILL BE VITAL TO MAINTAIN A CERTAIN MOMENTUM DURING THE CAMPAIGN. THIS WILL REQUIRE AREA COMMITTEES TO WORK OUT PHASES THROUGH WHICH THE CAMPAIGN SHOULD GO, EG. INTENSIVE HOUSE TO HOUSE CAMPAIGN, CHURCH VISITS, CALLING PUBLIC MEETINGS, ETC.

4. AREA COMMITTEES

IT IS CLEAR THAT ALL THIS WILL REQUIRE DISCIPLINED ORGANIZATION. TO THIS END THE TVL HAS SET UP A REGIONAL CO-ORDINATING COMMITTEE, MANNED BY VOLUNTEERS FROM VARIOUS AREAS. VARIOUS AREAS WILL HAVE TO SET UP THEIR OWN AREA COMMITTEES WHICH WILL LIASE CLOSELY WITH THE REGIONAL COMMITTEE. A HOST OF TASKS WILL HAVE TO BE PERFORMED BY THE AREA COMMITTEE E.G. ISSUING, KEEPING AND FORWARDING COMPLETED FORMS TO THE REGIONAL COMMITTEE.

5. ORGANIZATIONS NOT AFFILIATED TO THE UDF

NUMEROUS ORGANIZATIONS HAVE INDICATED THEIR PREPAREDNESS TO CO-OPERATE WITH THE UDF IN ITS CAMPAIGNS ALTHOUGH FOR ONE REASON OR THE OTHER THEY CAN NOT AFFILIATE TO THE UDF. THIS IS ONE CAMPAIGN DURING WHICH THESE ORGANIZATIONS SHOULD BE APPROACHED AND ROPED INTO OUR CAMPAIGN.

IN THIS REGARD VERY CLOSE CO-OPERATION BETWEEN AREA COMMITTEES AND THE REGIONAL OFFICE WILL HAVE TO BE MAINTAINED. AREA COMMITTEES SHOULD CREATIVELY THINK OF HOW TO INVOLVE ORGANIZATIONS OTHER THAN THOSE MENTIONED ABOVE. THE SECRETARIES SHOULD BE CONSULTED IN THIS REGARD.

6. CONDUCT OF ACTIVISTS

ACTIVISTS INVOLVED IN THE MILLION SIGNATURE CAMPAIGN, SHOULD AT ALL TIMES CARRY THE IMAGE OF THE UDF. THIS IS IMPORTANT BECAUSE ON EACH ACTIVISTS COLLECTING SIGNATURES IS A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UDF.
