- 1297 bibliographic records
- 3500-4000 Exam Papers
- Exam Papers are available in pdf format
- No paper copies available

Where do I Find Exam Papers?

- Past Exam Papers are available ***electronically*** in the Library Catalogue (called UPexplore).
- No paper copies are stored in the Library.

Conditions for access

- You need to be registered as a library user to obtain entry - verification by means of your surname and student number.
- You need [Adobe version 7.0](#) in order to download pdf files.
- Exam Papers are available only if it has been submitted to the Library by the Departments or Schools soon after the exams have been completed.

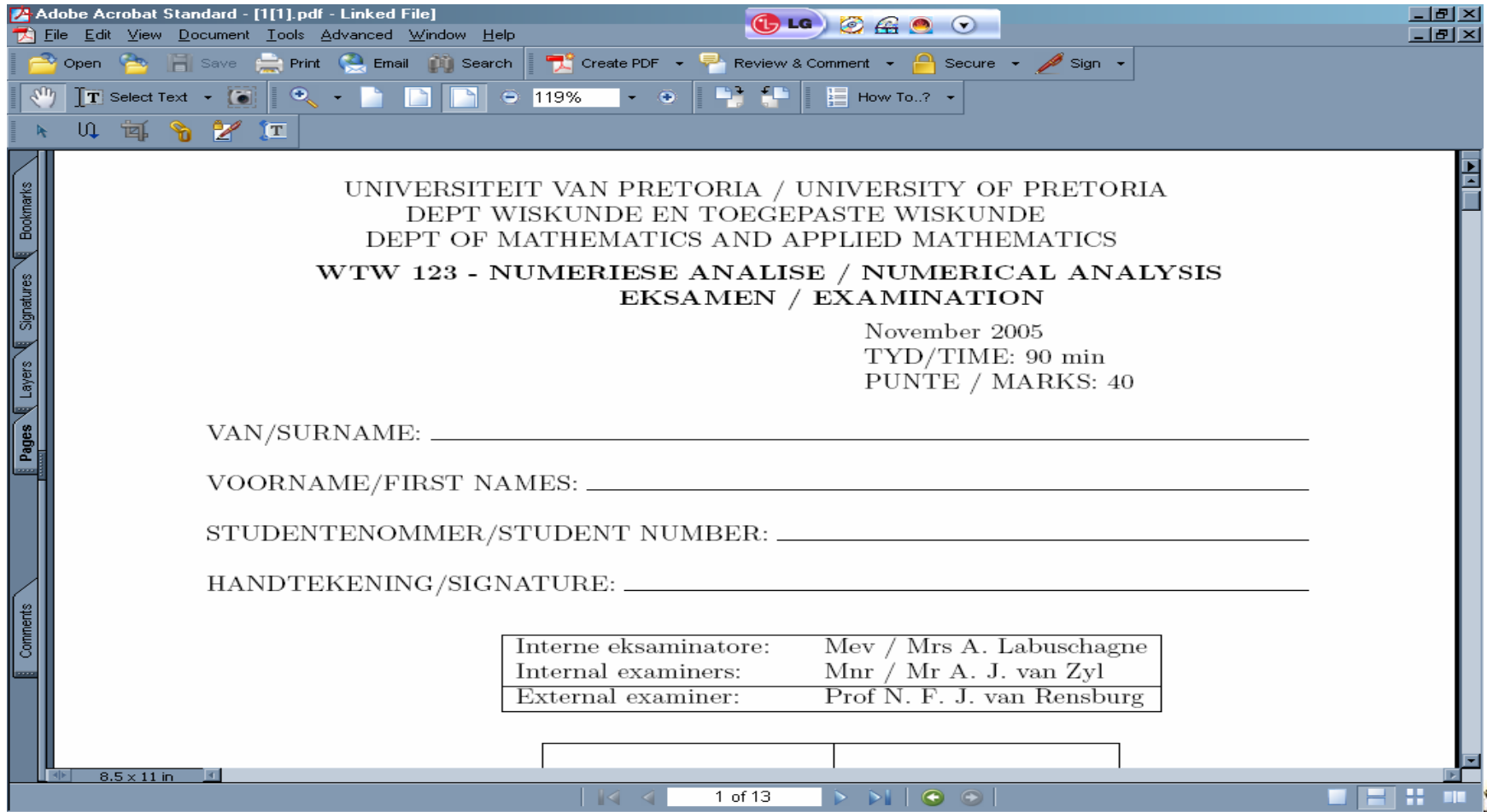
