

On Saturday, the 19<sup>th</sup> of April, the Lord Bishop of Pretoria dedicated the Church of St. Helen on the farm "Sunnyside" in the Waterberg Bushveld.

Behind that statement lie six years of steady growth which began with a visit to the farm by the Rev. "Took" Meggill, who, at the request of Mr. S. A. Davidson, the owner of the farm, decided to send a teacher-catechist to live there and evangelise the people. Soon after the arrival of the catechist a school was built, since when the work has steadily grown, and the first confirmation was held by Bishop Parker in 1949.

Then, two years ago, Mr. Davidson decided to build a church in memory of his daughter Helen, who died at an early age and who had spent many happy days at Sunnyside. The proposal was received with great enthusiasm by the congregation, and the work was begun. All was done by voluntary labour, Mr. Davidson himself going there for days at a time,
