March 31st 1984 - Tapestry embroidered kneelers for the altar rails Made and given by Diana Hagley and Rosalind King in memory of Frank and Elizabeth Clarke (their parents) and Paul Hagley. Blessed by Horace Gaylard at a Communion Service on 31st March 1984.

Good New Bibles - Peter and Janet Farrant - on the occasion of their 10th Wedding Anniversary 14.12.1984

Cupboard for Hymn Books and Vestments in Vestry - Stan Mathewson - sometime in 1985?

Pew for in front of the Organ and at back of the Church - Stan Mathewson sometime in 1987?

November 1988 - New box for the Hymn Numbers - given by Roy, Rosemary and Russel Thomsen. Made by Roy. Given when Rosemary left for England with Russel. Roy left exactly one year later having only then sold the farm.

19th March 1989 - New Fair Linen Cloth for Altar - made and embroidered by hand by Mrs Patricia Beith. Used for the first time Palm Sunday 19th March 1989.

June 1989 - Mrs Hilda Brett gave 12 new kneelers to the Church. Garry Farrant paid for the binding of the 2 strip of carpet in the aisles.

Hilda Brett and Miss Mary Chaney contributed to the cost of the 4 new cushions for the pews on the R.H.S. of the Church.

July 1989 Mrs H Durham of P O Box 182 Dundee gave a painting of the Church and Mr and Mrs S Mathewson paid for it to be framed.

When they left the Parish in January 1989 Mr and Mrs Alex Furman gave a Tile painting of the Church which was in their possession.
