
Article processing charge



- Article processing charge (APC) = publication fee/costs
- Fee charged to make work available in either
 - open access journal or
 - hybrid journal
- Fee is intended to cover peer review-related costs and editorial staff
- Journal dependent
- Paid by the author, the author's institution, or research funder

Types of journals



- Open access information available free of charge to reader; author pays/ subsidized (by a government entity, professional society, or the like)
- Subscription reader pays to obtain information (except if institution has a subscription, which they pay for); no charges for author
- Hybrid subscription with the option of open access; mixture of above



Costs

OPEN ACCESS

- Differs according to the academic publishers
- Below \$100 to over \$5000 [€9500 for the journal Nature]
- Costs of efficiently publishing a scholarly article between €200-€1000
- High fees are sometimes charged by traditional publishers in order to publish in a hybrid open access journal
- Shock for many aspiring research authors is in the "post-acceptance fees"
- NB read all of the fine print if you want to consider publishing in an OA journal
- Know all the fees upfront



Cost offset

- Ask for full or partial waiver
- Article cost waivered if editor of special edition
- If you have the funds and it's worth it to you, be prepared to pay!
- Include in funding proposal
- University will subsidize 50%
 - Student first author
 - High impact journal







- ✓ Increased citation and usage:
 Studies have shown that open access articles are viewed and cited more often than articles behind a paywall.
- ✓ Greater public engagement: Content is available to those who can't access subscription content.
- ✓ Increased interdisciplinary conversation: Open access journals that cross multiple disciplines help researchers connect more easily and providing greater visibility of their research.

- ✓ Wider collaboration: Open access publications and data enable researchers to carry out collaborative research on a global scale.
- ✓ Faster impact: With permissive licences like CC BY, researchers are empowered to build on existing research quickly.
- ✓ Compliance with open access mandates: Open access journals and books comply with major funding policies internationally.




- Speed of Publication vs a Long 'Paper Wait'
 - OA cuts down on valuable wait time to publication



OA journals result in higher impact factor due to better accessibility



Citations



Higher visibility = higher # citations

Measure of scholarly output


H-index indicator of productivity and impact of research

More publications cited, greater H-index
