What do funders look for

- Funding agencies have different agendas and interests
- Researchers to familiarise themselves with objectives and mandates of funding agencies
- Common amongst all is a researchers track record(research outputs, student supervision, securing external funding, etc.)

Research outputs in grant applications

- Research outputs (books, journals, etc.) are important to most funding agencies
- DRI currently does not currently track this against active grants (except for RDP)
- Encourage our researchers to update CV (NRF)

To increase visibility....

- We encourage and support researchers to apply for external funding;
- We encourage and support UP researchers in engaging in collaborative research;
- Engage in science communication ;
- Always include their institutional affiliation on e.g. grant applications, UK and US Funding agencies, publications, etc.); and
- Create Orcid accounts
