CORRECTION

The bacterial isolate from trout referred to in this article was recently re-examined. It was initially thought to be *Aeromonas salmonicida*, but using a much

larger series of biochemical tests, it was found to be *Vibrio (Listonella) anguillarum*. *V. anguillarum* has been associated with furunculosis in marine and fresh-water fish, causing lesions as described in the article.
